using the drawings you created for part 1 of this project, you are going to create the animatic video.

If your pictures were hand drawn...

You are going to use the class cameras to take photos of your drawings, then save those photos to your computer.

If your pictures were digitally drawn...

You're already a step ahead! Just import them into Final Cut!

Your animatic must...

- 1. ...be a minimum of 30 seconds in length.
- 2. ...include background music.
- 3. ...include a title at the beginning.
- 4. ...include either text, narration, or voiceovers (or a combination of all three).

5. ... be edited using Final Cut here at school.

*Remember, the goal of an animatic is to create a clear pre-visualization of your scene/story. It should "play out" exactly as you envision it playing out if it were made into an actual movie. This may require you to add more photos on top of the 5 photos that you created for part 1 of this project, as well as add more detail to those 5 photos.

Point Breakdown:

- -Background Music (10 points)
- -Beginning Title (10 points)
- -Text, narration, or voiceovers (40 points)
- -Effort/Creativity (40 points)
- *Minimum 30 Second requirement:

-Every second under = loss of 1 point (Up to 10 points worth)
