-Editing technique (Good "Matching the Action", good use of sound effects, etc.)

-Quality
Audio (Is the dialogue clear and understandable? Are there any distracting background noises?) (20 Points)
Video (Is it focused and framed well? Does it contain a variety of shot types, angles, and movements? Do the shot types, angles, and movements convey the feeling/emotion that they're intended to?) (20 Points)
-Continuity (Clothing, props, etc. must be consistent) (20 Points)
-Character Arc (30 points)
-Participation/Effort (30 Points)
*1-5 minute minimum requirement (-15 Points)
1 second under = -1 point
*Video must not contain any profanity, derogatory, or offensive terms or references to drug or alcohol use (this includes the music).
