Intro to Final Cut and Slideshow Project

Getting started

- 1. Open Final Cut Pro.
- 2. Click File > New > Event. Name your event *Slideshow*. Click OK.
- 3. Click File > New > Project. Name your project "Your Name" Slideshow. Click OK.

Import Images/Clips/Music

- *Note: In order to complete step 4 you must currently have your images and song saved to your computer. Mr. T will demonstrate how to do this if you need help.
- 4. Click File > Import > Media.
- 5. Search for the images and song that you have saved to the computer.
- 6. Click Import Selected.

Creating your movie

- 7. From the media bin, select the images you want to add to your movie.
- 8. Drag on drop those images onto your timeline in the order you want them to play in your video.
- *To add music to your timeline, repeat steps 7 and 8, but drag and place the song(s) on the layer underneath your images.
- 9. To shorten or lengthen the duration of the images and song, click on the image or song on your timeline to highlight it. Then click on the beginning or end of each image or song and drag outward to lengthen or inward to shorten.

Export/"Share" your movie

- 10. Click File > Share > Master File (default).
- 11. Click on Settings
- 12. Change Format to Computer.
- 13. Ensure that each setting is as follows...

Video Codec: H.264 Faster Encode

Resolution: 1280 x 720

Open With: QuickTime Player (default)

- 14. Click Next.
- 15. Ensure that the name of your movie and file destination are correct.
- 16. Click Save.
